

The End of the Rainbow

Make your own pot of gold!

What you'll need:

- Paper plate
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Quarter
- 1 sheet of yellow construction paper
- Gold glitter glue
- Colored pencils, crayons or markers
- Glue stick or tape
- Shamrock pattern (below)
- 1 sheet of green construction paper

What to do:

1. Cut the paper plate in half.
2. With a pencil, trace around a quarter 10 times on the yellow construction paper.
3. Squeeze a drop of gold glitter glue onto each circle and spread out with the tip of the tube of glitter glue. Let dry completely.
4. Cut out the yellow circles and set aside.
5. Color the back of one of the paper plate halves black. Then cut a triangle-shaped notch into each side of the plate (as pictured).
6. On the back of the other plate half, color stripes, about a quarter-inch wide, all around the curved edge to make it look like a rainbow. Start with red on the edge, then orange, yellow, green, blue, and finally purple.
7. After coloring the purple stripe, cut off the uncolored portion of the plate. Attach the rainbow to the pot with glue or tape.
8. Use a glue stick to attach the yellow circles to the edge of the black half of the paper plate to look like a pile of gold.
9. Cut out the shamrock pattern at right. Trace around it on the green construction paper and cut out. Glue the green shamrock to the black part of the paper plate.
10. Hang your pot of gold at the end of the rainbow over a door knob! — *Craft and page design by Mandy Kent and Richard G. Biever*
