

RIGHT TREE, RIGHT PLACE. ______

TREE TYPES

The taller a tree will become, the further it needs to be from overhead lines.

SMALL | <20 FT

If planting within 15 feet of power lines





Serviceberry

Common Hawthorn

MEDIUM | 25-50 FT

Plant minimum 20 feet from overhead lines

LARGE | 40+ FT

Plant 50+ feet away from overhead lines

TREES NOT SUITABLE NEAR POWER LINES

CONSIDER THE HEIGHT. Will it come within 10 feet of power lines when it's fully grown?

FOLLOWING CANOPY SPREAD. How wide will the tree grow?

WHEN SELECTING GROWTH RATE. A slow-growing species is typically stronger and lives longer than fast-growing species. A TREE SHAPE. A columnar tree grows in less space. Round or V-shaped trees provide more shade.
