Young Artists Honored By State's Electric Cooperatives

Indianapolis, Ind. — Twenty-two young Hoosier artists were recently honored as winners of the annual Cooperative Calendar of Student Art Contest.

The contest, sponsored by **Electric Consumer**, invites young artists from around the state to submit artwork reflective of the calendar month for which their grade level is assigned. For example, high school seniors submit artwork for the month of December. This year, in honor of our state's bicentennial in 2016, students were asked to incorporate an element of Indiana history, culture, landscape or location in their artworks. The Indiana Bicentennial Commission has named the calendar a "Legacy Project."

Submissions were then judged and winners from each grade level selected. Those winners will then represent that specific month in the 2016 "Cooperative Calendar of Student Art." Nine honorable mention winners are also included in a special section of the calendar.

One student from the group is also selected as Artist of the Year/Best of Show winner. This year, seventh grader Evan Olinger, Sellersburg, earned the coveted designation.
